ENTRY. - Direct Entry for all Competitions MUST be made on the prescribed form and such entry should be in the hands of the Festival Organiser not later than March 31st. All Entries will be acknowledged by post. If Competitors do not receive a Confirmation of Entry within two or three weeks, it is their responsibility to contact the organiser to verify that they are entered in the relevant Competitions. Qualifying Competitions will be held for the British Rising Stars Amateur Latin and Ballroom Competitions and the British Amateur Latin and Ballroom Championships. All British Amateur Competitors entering the British Amateur Championships/Competitions **MUST** be registered with their National Amateur Association and will be required to quote their registration number on the Entry Form. This rule applies to both the lady and the gentleman.

All British Professional Competitors in the Championships/Competitions must be registered with the British Dance Council and will be required to quote their Registration number on the Entry Form.

Non British Competitors are eligible provided they are recognised as Amateurs OR Professionals under the Rules of the British Dance Council.

Competitors must be registered with their own National/Countries Organisation.

Any suspensions by Governing Organisations, National OR International, will be considered before acceptance of Entry.

Amateur/Professional: 16 years of age or over.

Over 35 Years: The lady and gentlemen must both be over 35 years of age. Proof of age may be required.

Under 21 Years: Competitions must be over 16 and under 21 years of age on the day of the Competition. Proof of age may be required.

Formation: Open to teams of amateurs who are entered and coached by a Teacher who is a member of a recognised Association. British Teams MUST be registered with the British Dance Council. Non British Teams must be registered with their own National/Countries Organisation.

#### **RULES** (continued)

There will be no Entry Fee, other than the General Admission to the Ballroom, and all Competitors will defray their own travelling expenses.

If any Competitor withdraws from any Competition after entry, immediate notification in writing should be made. Failure to do this renders them liable to disqualification from entering any future events.

The Management reserve the right to limit the number of entries accepted in any of the competitions.

The decision of the Organiser is to be taken as final.

PLEASE NOTE - No late entries will be accepted and there will be no spare numbers, nor will anyone be allowed to dance in place of competitors who have not claimed their numbers.

**JUDGING** - For all Competitions the Board of Adjudicators will consist of members selected from the various Associations of Teachers of Dancing, together with any other Judges who may be appointed.

The decision of the Adjudicators is to be taken as final.
